The officers again want to Thank You for your tireless dedication to being Ambassadors for the Postal Service and keeping the economy moving. You also have shown great dedication to following the recommended practices which allow you to remain safe during the Pandemic, especially masks and social distancing.

I would like to encourage you to not let your guards down and continue to wear your masks and to social distance while at work and at home.

Don't be fooled into thinking just because restaurants, casino's and waterparks are opening up that the fight against Covid-19 is over, because it is not. In talking to some of the more recent individuals who have tested positive they stated they were around family members who had tested positive, or they attended a function where there was no social distancing or they didn't believe it could happen to them.

The Consolidated Casing Test grievance has been resolved by President Rolando and Vice President of Labor Relations Doug Tulino. The resolution has 2 phases. In phase 1 management will determine 31 of test sites which will be returned to their original route

structure by July 31,2020. The remaining 31 sites including Station A are in phase 2 and will continue through November 27,2020 and be returned to their original route structure by January 22, 2020.

The second time of doing the test was not the charm for the Post Office. Grievance violations and out of schedule pay Nationwide I'm sure will exceed what the Postal Service paid out in 2011-2012.

Due to Covid- 19 the NALC Annual Food Drive was postponed. President Rolando recently announced the Stamp Out Hunger Donor Drive.
